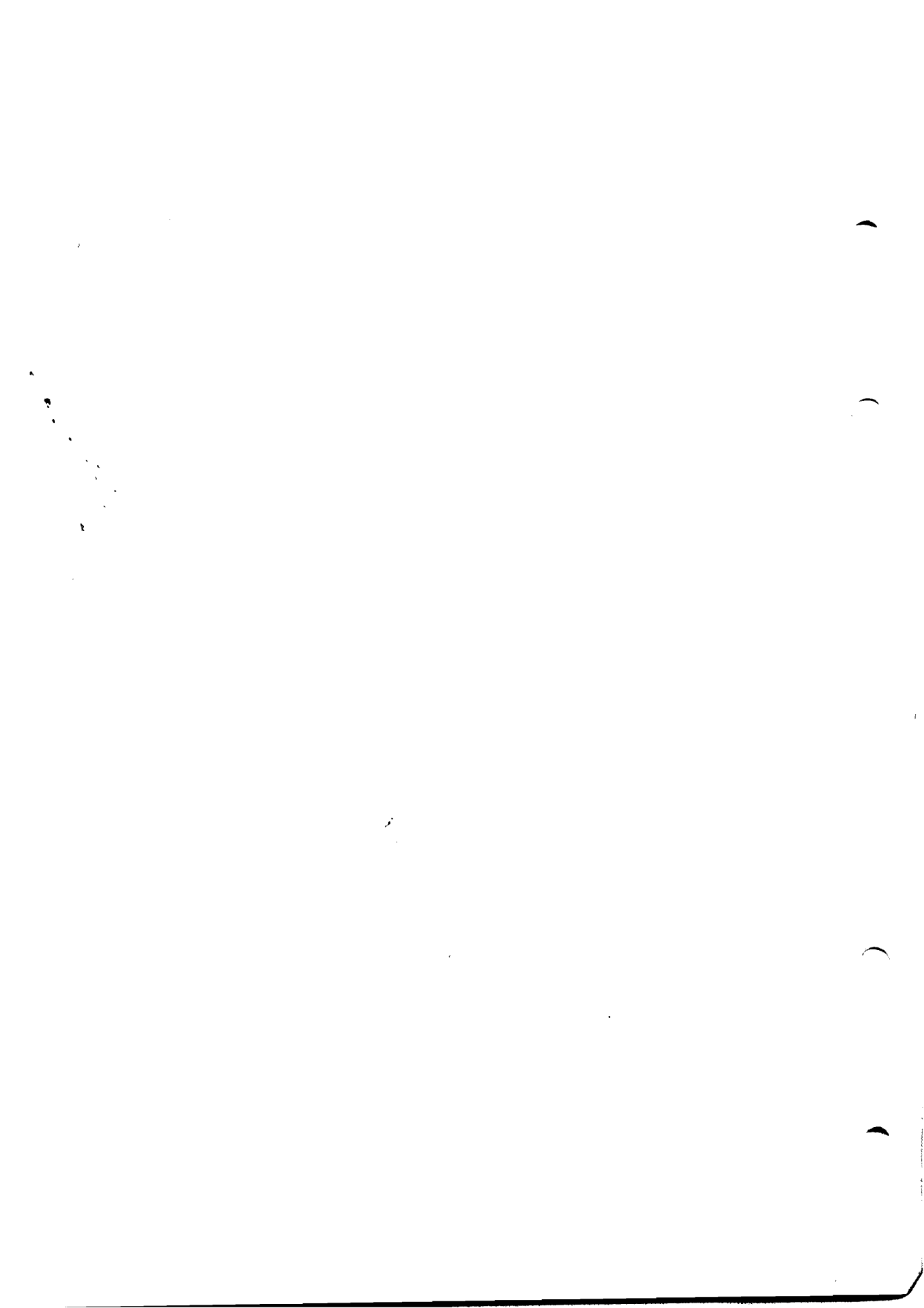

## TRESPASS ON ROYAL PROPERTY ACT

**An Act to make provision for the punishment of persons committing criminal trespass on the property of His Majesty the Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan**

1 of 1918  
(Cap. 23 of  
1951)

*Commencement: 1st January 1918*

1. This Act may be cited as the Trespass on Royal Property Act. Short title

2. In this Act the expression "criminal trespass" shall bear the meaning assigned to it by section 441 of the Penal Code. Interpretation

3. Whoever commits criminal trespass by entering upon any property belonging to His Majesty the Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan shall be guilty of an offence. Penalty imprisonment for 2 years and a fine of \$2,000. Trespass on  
Royal Property

4. Nothing in this Act shall operate to relieve any person found committing on any property belonging to His Majesty any of the offences defined in sections 443 to 446 inclusive of the Penal Code of any penalty to which he may be liable under sections 449 to 460 inclusive of the Penal Code.
