Rules for Guidance of the Members And WHEREAS it is Our Will and Pleasure that Members shall have and enjoy the Statutes and Ordinances for their Guidance in availing themselves of the said Most Faithful Order, to the Glory of God and for the Welfare of Our Country:

Sovereign of the Order has all power in regard to the Statutes

NOW, THEREFORE, by these Presents, sealed with the Seal of the said Most Faithful Order, We do Make, Ordain and Establish and have hereby Made, Ordained and Established the following Statutes and Ordinances, declaring that solely to Us, Our Heirs and Successors, Sultans of the State and Territory of Brunei and all its Dependencies, Sovereigns and Chiefs of the said Most Faithful Order, doth and shall belong all power of Abrogating, Amending, Altering, Adding to, Augmenting or Explaining the said Statutes or any particular therein.

Style and Designation 1. These Statutes shall be styled and designated as the Statutes of the Most Faithful Order of Perwira Negara Brunei (Darjah Perwira Negara Brunei Yang Amat Setia).

The Motto 2. The Motto of this Most Faithful Order shall be "Perwira ada-lah tiang Negara".

Sovereigns and Chiefs of the Order 3. We, Our Heirs and Successors, Sultans of the State and Territory of Brunei and of all its Dependencies, are and forever shall be Sovereigns and Chiefs of the said Most Faithful Order.

4. The Order may be awarded posthumously.

Constitution 5. The Order shall consist of the Sovereign and 2 Classes of Memof the Order bers.

2 Classes of Members of the Order 6. The 2 Classes of Members of this Order shall be styled and designated respectively —

Ordinary Members 7. The Persons to be admitted as Ordinary Members of either of the 2 Classes of this Order shall be such persons, male and female, as have performed or shall hereafter perform acts of the most conspicuous gallentry or bravery or preminent acts of valour or self-sacrifice.

Use of Initials 8. Any person who has been or may hereafter be admitted to either of the 2 Classes of this Order, that is to say, Perwira Agong Negara

Brunei or Perwira Negara Brunei, may on all occasions when the use of such is customary, place after his or her name, the letters P.A.N.B., or Pa.N.B., as the case may be.

9. The Seal of this Order shall bear the design approved by Us on The Seal the 27th day of July, 1961.

10. Members of both Classes of the Order shall wear the Badges of Method of wearing the the Order on the left side of their outer garments.

There shall be 4 Officers appointed by Us or Our Heirs and Officers of 11. the Order Successors to the Order, that is to say: a Chancellor (Menteri), a Prelate (Imam), a Secretary and Registrar (Juru-tulis) and a Gentleman Usher (Bentara), which Officers shall rank among each other in the above Order.

12. The Chancellor shall, in addition to the duties prescribed, hold The Chancelthe Seal of the Order and shall countersign all Warrants signed by Us, Our Heirs or Successors.

The Secretary and Registrar shall, in addition to the duties pre- The Secret-13. scribed, record all proceedings in connection with this Order in a Register to be appropriated for that purpose, and shall, under the direction of the Chancellor, prepare all Warrants and other Instruments to be passed under the Seal of the Order and engross the same.

14. All and every of the Officers of this Order shall, over and above Duties of the the duties more specifically imposed by these Statutes, execute diligently whatsoever the Sovereign may be pleased to command touching the interests of the Order and that the said Offices shall be holden during good behaviour.

15. Cancellation and annulment of appointment

16. It shall be competent of Us, Our Heirs and Successors by a Warrant signed by Us or Them, and sealed with the Seal of this Order, on the recommendation to that effect by Our Chiefs and Councillors and Advisers, to cancel and annul the appointment of any person to either of the Classes of this Order and thereupon his or her name in the Register shall be erased; but it shall be competent for Us, Our Heirs and Successors to restore to this Order any person whose appointment may have been cancelled and annulled when such recommendation has been withdrawn.

Badge to be returned on cancellation or annulment of appointment 17. In the event of the cancellation or annulment of the appointment of any person to either of the Classes of this Order, he or she shall return the Badge theretofore worn by him or her for service of the Order to the Secretary and be by him deposited with the Chancery.

Return of Badge on resignation or promotion 18. On the resignation of any Member of this Order from his or her Rank as a Member of the Order, or of any Officer from his Office, he or she shall forthwith return his or her Badge to the Secretary; and on the promotion of a Member of the said Order from the Second Class to the First Class, he or she shall likewise immediately return the Badge previously worn by him or her to the Secretary.

Return of Badge of deceased Ordinary Member 19. On the death of any Ordinary Member of this Order, his or her Badge shall be returned to the Secretary by his or her heirs or representatives unless they shall receive a written intimation from the Chancellor of the Order, that it is the Gracious Pleasure of the Sovereign to permit the Retention of such Badge by the heir or heirs of the deceased Member as a Mark of Royal Affection and Favour.

Secretary to secure return of Badge
20. If there should be any refusal or failure on the part of a Member or Members of this Order to return the Badges, as required by Statutes 17, 18 and 19, it shall be competent for the Secretary and he is hereby authorised, empowered and required to seek for, ask, demand and secure from each and every Member, if living, or from the heirs, executors and administrators where they are already deceased or that hereafter may decease, the return of the Badges which such Member or Members may have already received or hereafter may receive from the Chancery.

Chancery 21. The Chancery of this Most Faithful Order shall be in the Lapau, Brunei.

Power reserved to alter the Statutes 22. Lastly, We reserve to Ourselves, Our Heirs and Successors the Power of Abrogating or Amending or Altering or Adding to or Augmenting or Explaining any of the aforesaid Statutes or any part there-

of, if and whenever We may deem it necessary or expedient so to do, and such Amendments, Alterations, Additions or Explanations shall be accepted as part and parcel of the Statutes of this said Most Faithful Order.
