CONSTITUTION OF BRUNEI DARUSSALAM (Order under Section 83(3))

EMERGENCY (LEGAL PROFESSION ACT) (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1994

In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 83(3) of the Constitution of Brunei Darussalam, His Majesty The Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan of Brunei Darussalam hereby makes the following Order —

1. This Order may be cited as the Emergency (Legal Profession Act) (Amendment) Order, 1994 and shall come into force on 1st. day of July, 1994.

Citation and commencement.

2. Section 29 of the principal Act is amended by inserting the following, before the word "which" in paragraph (i) of subsection (2) —

Amendment of Section 29 of Chapter 132.

", other than an act which he is permitted to do in Brunei,".

3. Section 40 of the principal Act is amended by inserting the following after the word "agreement" in paragraph (b) of subsection (1) —

Amendment of Section 40.

", other than any agreement for the taking of contingency fees made in accordance with rules made under Section 65,".

4. Section 65 of the principal Act is amended by inserting the following new paragraph (aa) after the end of paragraph (a) of subsection (2) —

Amendment of Section 65.

"(aa) prescribe the manner in which contingency fees, as defined in such rules, may be taken by advocates and solicitors and the proceedings in which and conditions on which these shall be payable;".
