PASSPORTS ACT (CHAPTER 146)

PASSPORTS (VISA) (EXEMPTION) (AMENDMENT) **ORDER**, 1998

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 4 of the Passports Act, His Majesty The Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan of Brunei Darussalam, hereby makes the following Order :--

1. This Order may be cited as the Passports (Visa) (Exemption) (Amendment) Order, 1998, and shall be deemed to have come into force on 12th. May, 1995.

2. The Passports (Visa) (Exemption) Order, 1985, (as amended) hereinafter referred to as the Order is hereby amended by adding after paragraph 4 the following new paragraph 5 :-

"5. Any person who is a citizen of any of the countries specified in the Fourth Schedule hereto and who holds a valid diplomatic or official passport and enters Brunei Darussalam on official business shall be exempted from the provisions of section 3(1) of the Passports Act (Chapter 146) relating to visa requirements provided he complies with such conditions as the Director of Immigration may impose in accordance with the directions of His Majesty The Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan of Brunei Darussalam.".

3. The Order is amended by adding thereto the following Fourth Schedule. Schedule :-
