PASSPORTS (VISA) (EXEMPTION) (AMENDMENT) (NO. 2) ORDER, 2004

In exercise of the power conferred by section 4 of the Passports Act, His Majesty the Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan hereby makes the following Order —

Citation and commencement.

1. This Order may be cited as the Passports (Visa) (Exemption) (Amendment) (No. 2) Order, 2004 and shall commence on the 1st. day of January, 2005.

Amendment of Fourth Schedule of S 2/85.

2. The Passports (Visa) (Exemption) Order, 1985, in this Order referred to as the principal Order, is amended in the Fourth Schedule by adding "UKRAINE".

Interpretation.

3. For the purposes of the principal Order, a valid service passport issued by Ukraine shall be deemed to be a valid diplomatic or official passport.
