**PASSPORTS ACT  
(CHAPTER 146)**

**PASSPORTS (VISA) (EXEMPTION) (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 2005**

In exercise of the power conferred by section 4 of the Passports Act, His Majesty the Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan hereby makes the following Order —

**Citation and commencement.**

1. This Order may be cited as the Passports (Visa) (Exemption) (Amendment) Order, 2005 and shall be deemed to commence on the 19th. day of June, 2005.

**Amendment of Fourth Schedule of S 2/85.**

2. The Passports (Visa) (Exemption) Order, 1985, in this Order referred to as the principal Order, is amended in the Fourth Schedule by adding "PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA".

**Interpretation.**

3. For the purposes of the principal Order, a valid service passport issued by the People's Republic of China shall be deemed to be a valid diplomatic or official passport.
