## LEGAL PROFESSION (PRACTISING CERTIFICATE) RULES

Commencement: 1st January 1987

#### Citation

1. These Rules may be cited as the Legal Profession (Practising Certificate) Rules.

#### **Petition for Admission Form 1**

2. A petition for admission under section 5 shall be in Form 1 in Schedule 1.

#### Forms 2 and 3

3. The certificates required under section 5(3) shall be in Forms 2 and 3 in Schedule 1.

## Application for practising certificate Form 4

**4.** An application for a practising certificate under section 13 shall be in Form 4 contained in Schedule 1.

#### **Declaration Form 5**

**5.** An application for a practising certificate shall be accompanied by a declaration in writing in Form 5 contained in Schedule 1.

#### Form of practising certificate

**6.** A practising certificate shall be in Form 6 in Schedule 1.

#### Fees Schedule 2

7. The fees set out in Schedule 2 shall be payable in relation to the matters specified therein.
