ROAD TRAFFIC (FORCES VEHICLES EXEMPTION) ORDER

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (Forces Vehicles Exemption) Order.

Exemptions from need of registration and licensing

2. (1) All motor vehicles belonging to or owned by His Majesty the Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan Forces stationed or visiting the State and the Royal Brunei Armed Forces are exempted from registration and licensing as provided for under sections 5 and 8(1) and the regulations made thereunder:

Provided that —

(a) such vehicles are driven by drivers duly authorised by the unit to which such vehicles belong;

(b) such vehicles are not used for hire or reward;

(c) such vehicles are not used to carry any passenger who is not a member or employee of His Majesty the Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan Forces, or any goods which do not belong to His Majesty the Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan Forces or the Forces or the Royal Brunei Armed Forces.

- (2) For the purpose of this Order, personal effects of any member of the Forces are deemed goods belonging to the Forces.

Exemption from need of driving licence issued under Act

3. Any member of His Majesty the Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan Forces or of the Royal Brunei Armed Forces may drive any vehicle belonging to such Forces, provided he is in possession of a driving permit to drive any particular vehicle belonging to such Forces and issued by a proper authority within such Forces:

Provided that such driving permit is not valid for the holder to drive any motor vehicle registered and licensed under the Act.

[Subsidiary]

Forces learner drivers

4. The provisions in section 18 and in the regulations made thereunder do not apply to Forces drivers who are learning to drive under the training and supervision of the appropriate authority within the Forces, provided that no vehicle used for such instruction is driven in convoy of more than two vehicles.
