## SEAMEN'S UNEMPLOYMENT INDEMNITY $\mathbf{ACT}$

An Act to provide for the payment of unemployment 8 of 1939 indemnity to seamen on the loss of their ships

S.99/59

#### Commencement: 2nd October 1939

- This Act may be cited as the Seamen's Unemploy-Short title ment Indemnity Act.
- 2. In this Act and in any rules made thereunder unless Interpretathe context otherwise requires —

"seamen" includes all persons employed on any vessel:

"vessel" means and includes every kind of vessel used in navigation.

(1) The owner of a vessel shall be bound to inde- Payment of mnify any seaman employed therein against unemployment resulting from the wreck or loss of such vessel.

- (2) The indemnity shall be paid for the days during which such seaman remains in fact unemployed and shall be at the same rate as the wages agreed to be paid to such seaman: Provided that the total amount payable shall not exceed 2 months' wages.
- (3) Any money due under this section may be recovered by suit in the appropriate court.
- His Majesty the Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan in Power to Council may from time to time make rules generally for the carrying out of the purposes of this Act.
