UNLAWFUL CARNAL KNOWLEDGE ACT

An Act to render unlawful the having of carnal knowledge of a girl under 16 years of age

Commencement: 15th January 1938

1. This Act may be cited as the Unlawful Carnal Knowledge Act. Short title

2. Any person who has or attempts to have carnal knowledge of a girl under the age of 16 years except by way of marriage shall be guilty of an offence: Penalty, imprisonment for a term which shall not be less than 2 years and not more than 7 years and to whipping not exceeding 24 strokes of the rattan in the case of an adult or 12 strokes of the rattan in the case of a youthful offender. Prohibition of carnal knowledge of girl under 16 years

3. It shall be a sufficient defence to any charge under this Act that the person charged had reasonable cause to believe that the girl was of or above the age of 16 years. Defence

4. The Court of a Magistrate shall have jurisdiction over offences under this Act and, notwithstanding anything to the contrary which may be contained in the Criminal Procedure Code, shall have power to impose the full penalty. Jurisdiction
