WEIGHTS AND MEASURES (FEES) REGULATIONS

Commencement: 1st July 1994

Citation.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Weights and Measures (Fees) Regulations.

Interpretation.

2. In these Regulations, an “inspector” means an inspector appointed under section 4 and includes a Senior Inspector and Chief Inspector.

Fees.

3. The fees shown in the Schedule are the fees which an inspector may charge in respect of registration, inspection, testing or calibration of weights and measures instruments.
