POISONS (ANTIBIOTICS) EXEMPTION ORDER

Commencement: 1st July 1957

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as the Poisons (Antibiotics) Exemption Order.

Interpretation.

2. In this Order, “the Act” means the Poisons Act (Chapter 114).

Exemption of antibiotics.

3. There is hereby exempted from the operation the Act and of any rules made thereunder any antibiotic contained in any manufacture or preparation intended for feeding animals.

Conditions.

4. This exemption is granted and shall be valid subject to the condition that any importation, possession for sale, sale or offering for sale of manufactures and preparations containing any antibiotic and any use thereof shall be solely for the feeding of animals.
