In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 28 of the Customs Enactment, 1954, the Sultan in Council has made the following order :—

1. This order may be cited as the Customs (Prohibition and Restriction on Imports and Exports) (Amendment) Order, 1956. Citation.

2. The Second Schedule to the Customs (Prohibition and Registration on Imports and Exports) Order, 1955, is amended by inserting immediately after the item "Rice, paddy and the products thereof" the following new item :— Amendment of the  
Second Schedule.

"Separated, skimmed or filled milk."

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

The effect of the above order is to prohibit the importation into the State of separated, skimmed or filled milk except under licence from the Controller of Customs.
