

No. S 7.—THE CUSTOMS ENACTMENT, 1954.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 28 of the Customs Enactment, 1954, the Sultan in Council ^{Enactment No. 5 of 1954.} has made the following order:—

Citation.

1. This order may be cited as the Customs (Prohibition and Restriction on Imports and Exports) (Amendment No. 2) Order, 1956.

Amendment of Fourth Schedule.

2. The Fourth Schedule to the Customs (Prohibition and Restriction on Imports and Exports) Order, 1955, is amended by inserting immediately before the item “Derris species (Tuba)” the following new item:— ^{G.N. No. S.68 of 1955.}

“Articles of an antique or historical nature made or discovered in Brunei.”
