

No. S26.—CUSTOMS ENACTMENT, 1954.

Pursuant to section 28 of the Customs Enactment, 1954, ^{Enactment No. 5}_{of 1954} the Sultan in Council has made the following Order :—

Citation.

1. This order may be cited as the Customs (Prohibition and Restriction on Imports and Exports) (Amendment) Order, 1958.

2. The First Schedule to the Customs (Prohibition and Restriction on Imports and Exports) Order is amended by deleting the words “The ‘SALK’ Polio Vaccine.”

Explanatory Note

Pursuant to its powers under section 28 of the Customs Enactment, 1954, the Sultan in Council prohibited the importation into the State of the “SALK” Polio Vaccine. As that is now considered a safe product, the purpose of this Order is to remove it from the list of prohibited imports.
