THE CONSTITUTION OF THE STATE OF BRUNEI, 1959

THE CONSTITUTION (TRANSFER OF FUNCTIONS AND CONSEQUENTIAL PROVISIONS) (No. 2) ORDER, 1959

(Made under section 80)

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 80 of the Constitution of the State of Brunei, 1959, the Sultan has made the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Constitution (Transfer of Functions and Consequential Provisions) (No. 2) Order, 1959, and shall come into force on the same day as Parts IV, V and VI of the Constitution.

2. In this Order, "Constitution" means the Constitution of the State of Brunei, 1959.

3. The functions vested in the State Council and in the Sultan in Council in the provisions specified in the Schedule are hereby vested in the Legislative Council.

4. Every reference in any written law to the Council of State shall be construed as a reference to the Legislative Council.

5. For the reference to the State Council in subsection (3) of section 244 of the Criminal Procedure Code, there shall be substituted a reference to the Privy Council.
