## THE BRUNEI NATIONALITY ENACTMENT, 1961

THE BRUNEI NATIONALITY (REGISTRATION) (AMENDMENT) REGULATION, 1964

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 18 of the Brunei Nationality Enactment, 1961, the Sultan in Council hereby makes the folowing Regulation:

Title and commencement.

- This Regulation may be cited as the Brunei S. 69 of Nationality (Registration) (Amendment) Regulation, 1964, and shall be read as one with the Brunei Nationality (Registration) Regulations, 1961, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations.
- 2. The Principal Regulations are hereby amended by inserting the following new Regulation immediately after Regulation 9 —

"Register of births outside the State to be kept.

9A. (1) The Registrar shall keep a Register of the birth of any person born outside the State on or after the Appointed Day whose father was at the time of birth of such person a subject of the Sultan by registration under Section 5 in from/L set out in form the Schedule hereto.

- (2) The Registrar shall every entry in the Register.
- (3) The particulars to be recorded in respect of the place and date of birth shall include a record of the Birth Certificate relating to the child or a Statutory Declaration in lieu thereof and, if the Sultan has in any particular case allowed a longer period than six months, shall include in column 5 of the entry relating to the applicant a reference to the decision of His Highness the Sultan."
