

THE ROAD TRAFFIC ENACTMENT, 1954

The Road Traffic (Forces Vehicles Exemption)
Order, 1966

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 91 of the Road Traffic Enactment, 1954, *No. 12 of 1954.* the Sultan in Council hereby makes the following Order —

1. This order may be cited as the Road Traffic Citation. (Forces Vehicles Exemption) Order, 1966.

2. All motor vehicles belonging to or owned by Her Majesty's Forces stationed or visiting the State and the Royal Brunei Malay Regiment are exempted from registration and licensing as provided for under section 5 and 8(1) of the Road Traffic Enactment, 1954 and the regulations made thereunder, provided —

Exemptions from need of registration and licensing.

- (a) such vehicles are driven by drivers duly authorised by the Unit to which such vehicles belong;
- (b) such vehicles are not used for hire or reward;
- (c) such vehicles are not used to carry any passenger who is not a member or employee of Her Majesty's Forces or of the Royal Brunei Malay Regiment, or any goods which do not belong to Her Majesty's Forces or the Forces or the Royal Brunei Malay Regiment.

For the purpose of this Order, personal effects of any member of the Forces shall be deemed to be goods belonging to the Forces.

3. Any member of Her Majesty's Forces or of the Royal Brunei Malay Regiment may drive any vehicle belonging to such Forces, provided he is in possession of a driving permit to drive any partic-

ular vehicle belonging to such Forces and issued by a proper authority within such Forces. Provided also such driving permit is not valid for the holder to drive any motor vehicle registered and licenced under the Road Traffic Enactment, 1954.

Forces Learner
Drivers.

4. The provisions in section 18 of the Road Traffic Enactment, 1954, and in the regulations made thereunder shall not apply to Forces drivers who are learning to drive under the Training and supervision of the appropriate authority within the Forces, provided that no vehicle used for such instruction is driven in convoy of more than two vehicles.
