**THE ROAD TRAFFIC ENACTMENT, 1954**  
**Road Traffic (Compounding of Offences) Rules,**  
**1967**

*No. 12 of 1954.* In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 86A of the Road Traffic Enactment, 1954, the Mentri Besar hereby makes the following rules :

1. These rules may be cited as the **Road Traffic (Compounding of Offences) Rules, 1967** and shall come into force on the **31st day of March, 1967.**
2. "Enactment" means the Road Traffic Enactment, 1954.

~~3. (1) The following offences are hereby prescribed, as offences which may be compounded by the Commissioner of Police or any police officer not below the rank of Assistant Superintendent specially authorised by name in that behalf by the Menteri Besar in accordance with section 86A of the Road Traffic Enactment, namely:—~~

*24 and 25/10 (S. 54/10)*  
Offences under section <sup>37(1)</sup> of the Enactment and Regulations 14, 20, 27, 29, 30, 31, 33, 34, 36, 49, 50, 51, 53, 55, 56, 57, 58, 60, 74, 75, 76, 101, 104, 106, 107, 108, 109, 112, 147, 149, 152 and 153 of the Road Traffic Regulations.

(2) The following are the offences which may be compounded by the Controller of Land Transport in accordance with section 86A of the Road Traffic Enactment.—

Offences against sections 54 and 72 of the Enactment.

~~4. When an offer of composition of any offence is made and accepted payment shall be made by cash or money order to the police officer authorised to make such offer of Composition or to the Controller as the case may be, shall account for it in ordinary way and issue a receipt for such payment to the person to whom the offer of Composition was made.~~

5. The forms contained in the schedule to these rules may be used for the purposes indicated by their contents but no deviation from such forms shall invalidate or affect the legality of any composition made.
