

THE CUSTOMS ENACTMENT, 1954

The Customs (Prohibition and Restriction on Imports and Exports) (Amendment) Order, 1971.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him *No. 5 of 1954.*  
by Section 28 of the Customs Enactment, 1954, the Sultan in Council hereby makes the following Order :—

Interpretation.

1. This Order may be cited as the Customs (Prohibition and Restriction on Imports and Exports) (Amendment) Order, 1971, and shall be read as one with the Customs (Prohibition and Restriction on Imports and Exports) Order (hereinafter referred to as the Principal Order).

Amendment of the 1955 Order.

2. The Second Schedule to the Principal Order which refers to "Restricted Imports" is hereby amended by adding the following new items, that is to say, "sugar, salt, converted timber".

Amendment of Fourth Schedule.

3. The Fourth Schedule to the Principal Order is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the following items:—

Cigarettes

Alcoholic Liquors

Interpretation.

4. In this Order the words "converted timber" shall bear that same meaning as in the Forest Rules.
