THE FISHERIES ENACTMENT, 1972 THE FISHERIES REGULATIONS, 1973

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by Section 4 of the Fisheries Enactment, 1972, the Mentri Besar hereby makes the following Regulations, 1973.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Fisheries Title. Regulations, 1973.

PART I

REGULATION OF FISHING

- 2. No person shall, except under the terms and conditions of a valid licence or where the fish captured or killed are intended solely for the consumption by the fisherman and his household and where none such fish are sold, in Brunei Waters:
 - (a) erect, maintain, use or operate any kilong;
 - (b) use for the purpose of catching or killing fish any kind of other fishing appliance.
- 3. No person shall, except under the terms and conditions of a valid licence:
 - (a) import into or export from Brunei or have in transit in Brunei any fish whether live or dead;
 - (b) act as a fish dealer;
 - (c) use or operate from Brunei any kilong or other fishing appliance.

- 4. No person shall:
 - (a) erect, maintain, use or operate any tugu;
 - (b) import, offer for sale, be in possession of or use any spear gun.

PART II LICENCES

- 5. Any Licencing Officer may, subject to the provisions of the Fisheries Enactment, 1972, issue to any person on such terms and conditions as he may specify, a licence for:
 - (a) a kilong;
 - (b) any other fishing appliance;
 - (c) the use of poisons or explosives;
 - (d) the disposal of fish in Brunei;
 - (e) the import, transit and export of fish.
- 6. The fees specified in Schedule A shall be payable in the respect of licences and renewal of licences.

PART III STATISTIC

7. Any fisherman and any fish dealer shall, to the best of his knowledge and belief, answer when so required, all questions asked of him by an Authorised Officer which are necessary to the obtaining of any information required for the compilation of statistic in relation to the fishing industry.
