

**POLICE FORCE ENACTMENT, 1949
POLICE (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS,
1975**

POLICE MARINE BRANCH ALLOWANCES

In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 62 of the Police Force Enactment, His Highness the Sultan in Council hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Police (Amendment) Regulations 1975 and shall be deemed to have come into force on 1st March, 1975. Citation.

2. Schedule 'C' of the Police Regulations, 1958, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations is amended:— New item in Schedule 'C'

(a) by adding immediately after item 14 the following new items:—

“Name of allowance	Qualification for allowance	Amount of Allowance per mensem
15. Marine Allowance	Police Marine Branch (a) Sergeant Major (b) Sergeant (c) Corporal (d) Constable	Thirty Dollars Twenty Dollars Twenty Dollars Ten Dollars
16. Marine Command Allowance	To Command a Police Marine Boat (a) Sergeant Major (b) Sergeant	Thirty Dollars Twenty-Five Dollars

The allowances at 15 and 16 are not payable to members of the Inspectorate.”

(b) by revoking paragraph (1) of the Conditions and including new paragraph (1) in place thereof, namely:— Revocation of paragraph (1) of Conditions and inclusion of new paragraph (1).

“(1) with the exception of detectives and detectives plain clothes and Marine Command allowances (Nos. 6, 7, 15 and 16) only one of the above allowances may be drawn at any one time, and then only for the period during which the non-commissioned officer or constable concerned is certified by his superior officer to be engaged on duties to which the allowance applies.”
