

**CUSTOMS ENACTMENT, 1954**

**(Enactment No. 5 of 1954)**

**Customs (Establishment of Customs Warehouse  
and Warehouse Rent) (Brunei International  
Airport) Order, 1981.**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 57 of the Customs Enactment, 1954 the State Secretary has made the following Order:—

Enactment No. 5  
of 1954

1. This Order may be cited as the Customs (Establishment of Customs Warehouse and Warehouse Rent) (Brunei International Airport) Order, 1981 and shall come into force on the Eighteenth day of August 1981.

Citation and  
commencement.

2. The warehouse specified in the First Schedule is hereby established as Customs Warehouse wherein goods may be deposited. Bonded stores are established at such warehouse, wherein goods may be deposited and left without payment of duty.

3. Warehouse rent shall be paid on all goods deposited in the Customs Warehouse at the rates specified in the Second Schedule and bonding rent shall be paid on all dutiable goods deposited in a customs bonded store at the rates specified in the Third Schedule:

Provided that —

- (a) no rent shall be chargeable for the first forty-eight hours of deposit;

- (b) when goods are deposited in a Customs Warehouse upon any day immediately preceding a day on which such warehouse is closed and are removed upon the first subsequent day during which such warehouse is open the intervening day or days during which such warehouse is closed shall not be counted for the purpose of assessing the rent due;
- (c) when it is shown to the satisfaction of the Controller that any goods deposited in a Customs Warehouse have been detained for any cause not attributable to an act or commission of the importer or his agent, he may on receipt of an application from the importer or his agent remit or refund the whole or part of the warehouse rent in respect of such goods; and
- (d) when any goods are removed from one Customs Warehouse to any other Customs Warehouse rent shall be charged as if such goods had remained in the Customs Warehouse wherein they first deposited:

Provided that rent shall not be charged in respect of the period during which the goods were in transit from one warehouse to another.

## FIRST SCHEDULE

### CUSTOMS WAREHOUSE — BRUNEI INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT, BERAKAS.

## SECOND SCHEDULE

1. The minimum rent for any period shall be 50 cents.
2. For the first week or part thereof — 50 cents per 100 kilos or part thereof per day reckoned on the gross packed weight of the goods.
3. For the second or any subsequent week or part thereof — \$1.00 (one dollar) per 100 kilos per day reckoned on the gross packed weight of the goods.

## THIRD SCHEDULE

### Rates of Customs Bonded store rent.

- (a) Intoxicating liquors 5 cents per gallon or part thereof
- (b) Cigars and Cigarettes 2 cents per mille or part thereof.
- (c) Other manufactured tobacco in containers of any kind for retail sale to the public 1 cent per lb. net weight of tobacco or part thereof.

(d) All other dutiable goods

(1) Per package not exceeding 133 lbs gross weight 15 cents

(2) Per package exceeding 133 lbs gross weight but not exceeding 266 lbs gross weight 30 cents

(3) Per package exceeding 266 lbs gross weight 60 cents
