

THE ROAD TRAFFIC ENACTMENT, 1954

Exemption under Regulation 18 of the Road Traffic Regulations as amended by the Road Traffic (Amendment) Regulations, 1981.

Pursuant to Regulation 18(3) of the Road Traffic Regulations as amended by the Road Traffic (Amendment) Regulations 1981, the Commissioner of Police and the Controller of Land Transport have given their written permission for the following description of tinted glass to be used or fitted to the windscreen or window of a motor vehicle —

- (a) originally manufactured tinted glass fixed to the windscreen or window of a motor vehicle. Such tinted glass shall have a degree of light transmission of 70° and above and is supported by test report from recognised laboratory.

(b) No locally tinted glass shall be fixed to the windscreen or window of a motor vehicle unless such tinted glass has a degree of light transmission of 70° and above and supported by test report from a recognised laboratory.

(c) For the purposes of this exemption —
“Locally tinted glass” means glass tinted with plastic film or paint.
“recognised laboratory” means the British Institute of Standards or the Japanese Institute of Standards.
