SUBORDINATE COURTS ACT (CHAPTER 6)

THE MAGISTRATES' COURTS (CIVIL PROCEDURE) (AMENDMENT) RULES, 1996

In exercise of the power conferred by subsection (1) of section 25 of the Subordinate Courts Act, the Chief Justice, with the approval of His Majesty The Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan, has made the following Rules of Court:—

- 1. These Rules may be cited as the Magistrate's Courts (Civil Procedure) Citation. (Amendment) Rules, 1996.
- 2. The Magistrates' Courts (Civil Procedure) Rules, 1992 are amended by the insertion of the following new rule immediately after rule 71 rule 71A.

"Procedure if no provision in Rules. 71A. Where there is no provision in these Rules for the appropriate procedure or form, the procedure and forms in force or used in the High Court may, if the Court thinks fit, be followed and adopted, as near as maybe.".
