## IMMIGRATION ACT (CHAPTER 17)

## **IMMIGRATION (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1997**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 53 of the Immigration Act, the Minister of Home Affairs with the approval of His Majesty The Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan has made the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Immigration (Amendment) Regulations, 1997 and shall come into force on the 1st. day of February, 1997.

Citation and Commencement.

2. The Immigration Regulations are amended by adding after regulation 34 the following new regulation 35-

New regulation

"Offences.

- 35. (1) Any person who without reasonable cause contravenes or fails to comply with any provision of regulation 9, 11, 15 or 16 shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on conviction to imprisonment for a term not exceeding 6 months or to a fine not exceeding \$2,000.00 or to both.
- (2) Any holder of any Pass issued under these regulations who without reasonable cause contravenes or fails to comply with any provisions of the Act or of any of these regulations or with any condition imposed in respect of or instruction endorsed on such Pass shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on conviction to imprisonment for a term not exceeding 6 months or to a fine not exceeding \$2,000.00 or to both ".
