**CONSTITUTION OF BRUNEI DARUSSALAM
(Order made under Article 83(3))**

EXIT AND ENTRY CHARGES ACT (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 2022

In exercise of the power conferred by Article 83(3) of the Constitution of Brunei Darussalam, His Majesty the Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan hereby makes the following Order —

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Exit and Entry Charges Act (Amendment) Order, 2022 and shall commence on 12th December 2022.

Amendment of long title of Chapter 232

2. The long title of the Exit and Entry Charges Act, in this Order referred to as the Act, is amended by deleting "persons" from the first line and by substituting "vehicles" therefor.

Amendment of section 3

3. Section 3 of the Act is amended, in subsection (2), by deleting "person or class of persons" and by substituting "vehicle or class of vehicles" therefor.

Amendment of section 4

4. Section 4 of the Act is amended, in the definition of "driver", by deleting "and includes a rider".

Amendment of section 6

5. Section 6 of the Act is amended —

(a) in subsection (1), by deleting "person" and by substituting "vehicle" therefor;

(b) in subsection (2), by deleting "the occupants of" from the last two lines.

Substitution of Schedule 1

6. Schedule 1 to the Act is repealed and the following new Schedule is substituted therefor —

"SCHEDULE 1
(sections 3(2) and 20)

VEHICLE OR CLASS OF VEHICLES TO WHICH ACT DOES NOT APPLY

1. Bicycle.
2. Motorcycle.
3. Vehicle which belongs to the Government or a government of another country when it is being used for official purposes.
4. Vehicle which belongs to officers under the Government or a government of another country in the execution of their duties.
5. Vehicle which belongs to the military forces raised and maintained under the Royal Brunei Armed Forces Act (Chapter 149).
6. Vehicle when it is being used for firefighting, ambulance or police purposes.
7. Vehicle when it is being used for the purpose of a funeral.
8. Vehicle driven by persons covered by the Diplomatic Privileges (Vienna Convention) Act (Chapter 117) and the Consular Relations Act (Chapter 118).".

Substitution of Schedule 2

7. Schedule 2 to the Act is repealed and the following new Schedule is substituted therefor —

"SCHEDULE 2
(sections 7 and 20)

1. Motor vehicles —		
<i>(a)</i> with 7 seaters or less	\$3	\$3
<i>(b)</i> with 8 to 25 seaters	\$6	\$6
<i>(c)</i> with more than 25 seaters	\$10	\$10

2. Commercial motor vehicles —

<i>(a)</i> without cargo scanning	\$6	\$6
<i>(b)</i> with cargo scanning	\$10	\$10."
