AIR NAVIGATION ACT

An Act to amend the law relating to air navigation

11 of 1978

Commencement: 1st March 1978

1. This Act may be cited as the Air Navigation Act. Short title

2. (1) The Orders in Council specified in the Schedule to this Act shall, to the extent specified in the Second Column of the said Schedule, be in force in Brunei with such formal alterations and amendments as may be necessary to make the same applicable to the circumstances of Brunei, and in particular subject to the exceptions, adaptations, and modifications, if any, set forth in the third column of the said Schedule, as if Brunei were a Territory to which such Orders extend. Application of Orders in Council

(2) Subject to any exception, adaption or modification set forth in the third column of the Schedule to this Act, any reference in any Order in Council to the Governor shall be construed as a reference to the Minister and any reference to the Secretary of State shall be construed as reference to His Majesty the Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan, and any regulations, rules, orders or directions which may be made or given by virtue of any Order in Council specified in the Schedule to this Act may be made or given by the Minister.

3. (1) The Minister may make regulations, not inconsistent with the provision of any international agreement or arrangement, relating thereto and applicable to Brunei, for — Power to make regulations for the purposes of aerial navigation and by-laws for aerodromes

(a) establishing and maintaining places, works and services for the purposes of aerial navigation; or

(b) prescribing measures to be taken in respect of aircraft, or of persons or things therein, arriving at or departing from any place in Brunei or flying within Brunei; or

(c) generally for regulating air navigation.

(2) With the approval of the Minister the Director of Civil Aviation may, in respect of any aerodrome managed or licensed by him, make bye-laws for regulating the use and operation of the aerodrome and the conduct of all persons while within the aerodrome.

(3) Any person contravening any regulations or bye-laws made in accordance with this section shall be liable on conviction to such fine or such term of imprisonment as may be specified in the regulations or bye-law.

Power to
make Order

4. His Majesty may by Order make provisions —

(a) amending or adding to the Schedule to this Act;

(b) with regard to any matters whether or not provided for by the Orders in Council specified in the Schedule to this Act;

(c) for enabling Brunei to implement any international agreement or convention; and

(d) for the better and more effectual carrying out of the provisions of this Act.
