SUBSIDIARY LEGISLATION

Notification under section 11(1) conferring special jurisdiction on magistrates

The Chief Justice has conferred upon the following magistrates, with effect from the 1st February 1989, special jurisdiction in a Court presided over by any such magistrate by increasing the power to pass a sentence of imprisonment to a term of 7 years and a fine of \$10,000—

- (a) the person occupying the post of Chief Magistrate;
- (b) the person occupying the post of Senior Magistrate;
- (c) the person occupying the post of Chief Registrar;
- (d) the person occupying the post of Deputy Chief Registrar;
- (e) any person occupying the post of Registrar; and
- (f) any qualified person meaning a person who is qualified for the purposes of the Legal Profession Act (Chapter 132) by virtue of section 3 thereof, occupying the post of Magistrate.
