Citation

1. These Rules may be cited as the Legal Profession (Practising Certificate) Rules.

Petition for Admission Form 1

2. A petition for admission under section 5 shall be in Form 1 in Schedule 1.

Forms 2 and 3

3. The certificates required under section 5(3) shall be in Forms 2 and 3 in Schedule 1.

Application for practising certificate Form 4

4. An application for a practising certificate under section 13 shall be in Form 4 contained in Schedule 1.

Declaration Form 5

5. An application for a practising certificate shall be accompanied by a declaration in writing in Form 5 contained in Schedule 1.

Form of practising certificate

6. A practising certificate shall be in Form 6 in Schedule 1.

Fees Schedule 2

7. The fees set out in Schedule 2 shall be payable in relation to the matters specified therein.
