TRESPASS ON ROYAL PROPERTY ACT

An Act to make provision for the punishment of persons 1 of 1918 committing criminal trespass on the property of His (Cap. 23 of 1951) Majesty the Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan

Commencement: 1st January 1918

- 1. This Act may be cited as the Trespass on Royal Prop- Short title erty Act.
- 2. In this Act the expression "criminal trespass" shall bear the meaning assigned to it by section 441 of the Penal Cap. 22 Code.
- 3. Whoever commits criminal trespass by entering upon Trespass on Royal Propany property belonging to His Majesty the Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan shall be guilty of an offence. Penalty imprisonment for 2 years and a fine of \$2,000.
- Nothing in this Act shall operate to relieve any person found committing on any property belonging to His Majesty any of the offences defined in sections 443 to 446 inclusive of the Penal Code of any penalty to which he may be liable under sections 449 to 460 inclusive of the Penal Cap. 22 Code.
