

**THE CONSTITUTION OF
THE STATE OF BRUNEI, 1959
THE EMERGENCY (STATUTORY FUNDS
SUPPLEMENTARY APPROPRIATION)
ORDER, 1963
(Order under Section 83(3) (5))**

WHEREAS His Highness the Sultan by a Proclamation of Emergency dated the 12th day of December, 1962 has declared a state of emergency in the State;

AND WHEREAS it is provided by sub-section (3) of section 83 of the Constitution of the State of Brunei, 1959, that when a Proclamation of Emergency has been made and for so long as such Proclamation is in force, the Sultan may make any Order whatsoever he considers desirable in the public interest; *S. 97 of 1959.*

AND WHEREAS it is provided by sub-section (5) of section 83 of the Constitution of the State of Brunei, 1959, that such powers shall include the power to make such financial provisions as may be necessary during the period of the emergency including provision for the public service;

NOW, THEREFORE, IN the exercise of the powers conferred on him by sub-section (3) and (5) of section 83 of the Constitution of the State of Brunei, 1959, His Highness the Sultan has made the following order :—

| Short title and commencement. | 1. This Order may be cited as the Emergency (Statutory Funds Supplementary Appropriation) Order, 1963, and shall be read as one with the Statutory Funds Appropriation Enactment 1959 (hereinafter called "the principal Enactment") and shall be deemed to have come into force on the 15th day of December, 1962. No. 9/1959. |
| Appropriation. | 2. An additional sum of Dollars Five Million (\$5,000,000) is hereby appropriated for the purpose of the Housing Loans Fund established under the principal Enactment. |
| Condition of Appropriation. | 3. The sum mentioned in section 2 shall be used for the purpose and subject to the provisions of the principal Enactment. |
| Charge on Consolidated Fund. | 4. The sum appropriated under section 2 is hereby charged on the Consolidated Fund. |
