POLICE FORCE ENACTMENT, 1949 THE POLICE (AMENDMENT)

REGULATIONS, 1971

In exercise of the powers conferred by 62 of the Police Force Enactment, 1949, His Highness the Sultan in Council hereby makes the following Regulations:—

Citation.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Police (Amendment) Regulations, 1971.

New Regulation 26A.

2. The Police Regulations, 1958 (hereinafter referred to as the "Principal Regulations") are hereby amended by inserting after Regulation 26 of the following new Regulation 26A:—

"Shooting Bonus.

26A. Shooting Bonus as set out in Schedule C(A) shall be payable to the Inspectorate and members of the Rank and File provided that not more than two such bonuses shall be payable to any individual in any one year."

Amendment of Schedule.

- 3. The Schedules to the Principal Regulations are hereby amended as follows:—
 - (i) The existing item 5 is hereby deleted and a new item 5 is substituted as follows:—
