

The Road Traffic (Exemption) Order

(Made under section 91 of the Enactment.)

[1st January, 1956.]

1. This order may be cited as the Road Traffic (Exemption) Order. Citation.

2. The persons and authorities specified in the first column of the Schedule to this order are exempted from such of the provisions of the Road Traffic Enactment, 1954, and the regulations made thereunder as are specified in the second column of the said Schedule in respect of the vehicles or class or description of vehicles specified in the third column of the said Schedule subject to the conditions set out in the fourth column of the said Schedule. Exemptions.
