## The Customs (Compoundable Offences) Regulations

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Customs (Compoundable Offences) Regulations.
- Compounding of offences.
  - 2. The offences set out in the Schedule are hereby prescribed to be compoundable for the purpose of subsection (1) of section 121 of the Customs Enactment, 1954, and may be compounded by any senior Officer of Customs.

## **SCHEDULE**

- (1) All offences contrary to paragraphs (e) and (f) of subsection (1) of section 124 of the Enactment; and
- (2) All offences contrary to paragraphs (d), (e), (f) and (g) of subsection (1) of section 126 of the Enactment where the difference between the amount of duty leviable and the amount that would have been paid if the offence had not been detected does not exceed five hundred dollars.
