LABOUR (LIMITATION OF DUTIES AND POWERS) RULES

Citation.

1. These Rules may be cited as the Labour (Limitation of Duties and Powers) Rules.

Limitation of Duties and Powers.

2. The duties and powers of any officer appointed under section 3(1) of the Act other than the Commissioner of Labour or any Deputy Commissioner of Labour or Assistant Commissioner of Labour shall be limited as follows, that is to say such officer may perform only the duties imposed and exercise only the powers conferred on the Commissioner by the following sections of the Act —
